- work as teachers in primary and secondary schools of music and general education as well as secondary vocational schools, on the condition that they gained the needed number of ECTS points from the appropriate group of psychological, pedagogical and methodological subjects at undergraduate studies;
- work in cultural institutions;
- work in media and culture management;
- work in the music industry.

The study program is designed to enable and support the further development of individual scientific, pedagogical and other professional skills of the students by offering them the possibility to continue their education at doctoral studies.
